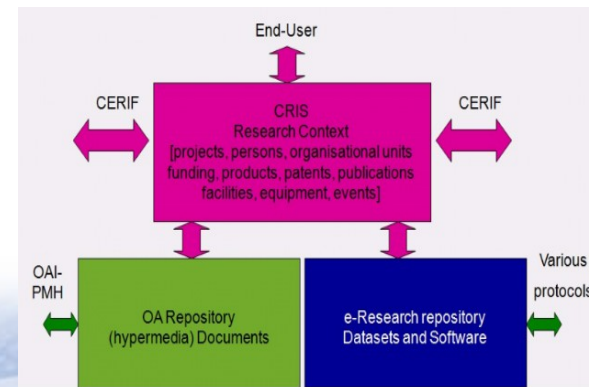
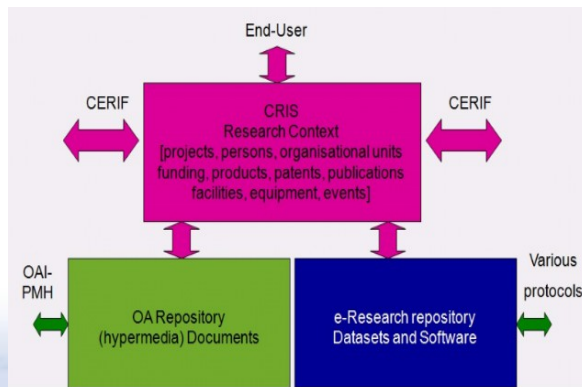
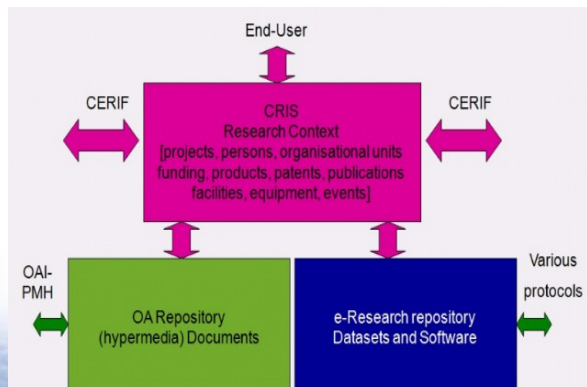
# RIM System Configuration at National Level

National/Regional/Funder CRIS

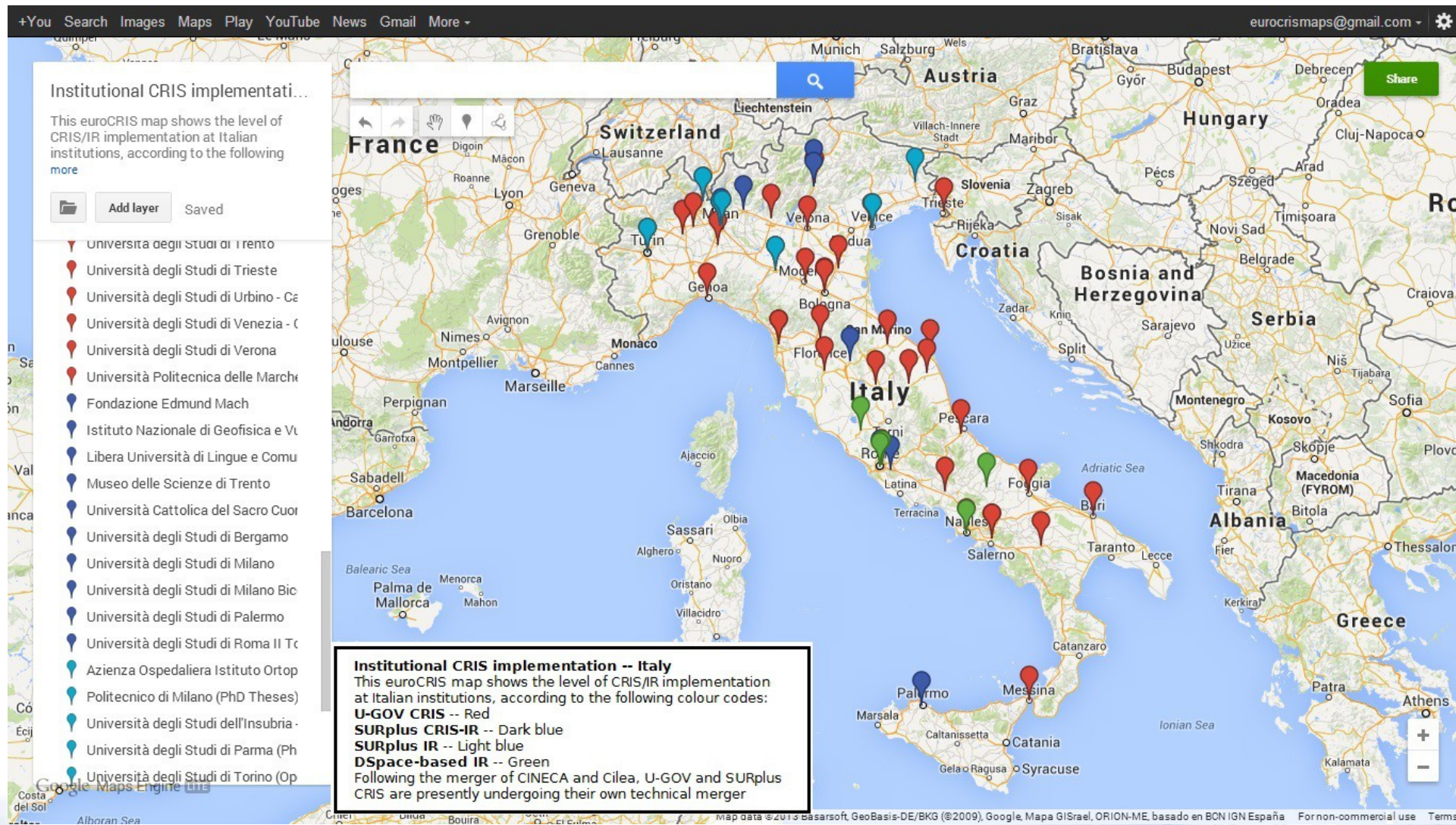


Institutional CRIS layer
